Since 1969, Share of McLean has been helping neighbors in need right here in our community.

- Share is an all-volunteer, community-based nonprofit serving neighbors in McLean and nearby communities who are facing food insecurity, financial hardship, and other challenges.
- We partner with local individuals, businesses, faith communities, schools, and organizations to provide food, clothing, furniture, and emergency financial assistance to those who need a helping hand.
- Because Share has no paid staff or fundraising expenses and operates from space generously donated by the McLean Baptist Church, your support goes directly to helping neighbors in need. Donations help put food on tables, furnish homes, provide emergency assistance, and make a meaningful difference in the lives of local families and individuals.

Who are our clients?

- Our clients are our neighbors. They are families, seniors, individuals, and children in our community who are facing a difficult time and need a helping hand.
- Share supports 1,400 households—more than 3,500 individuals—including neighbors experiencing financial hardship, living on fixed incomes, or facing food insecurity.
- Many are referred to Share by local faith communities, county social workers, school counselors, and other nonprofit organizations that recognize when a neighbor needs support.
- For those we serve, Share provides more than food or emergency assistance. It provides a sense of hope, dignity, and community when they need it most.



How we Help

- **Food and Clothing Pantry** – Share provides nutritious food and quality, gently used clothing to eligible neighbors in McLean, Great Falls, and the Pimmit section of Falls Church. Each month, more than 1,300 bags of groceries and other essential items help local families put food on the table and meet everyday needs.
- **Emergency Financial Aid** – When an unexpected expense threatens a family's stability, Share can help. In partnership with Fairfax County, we provide emergency assistance for rent, utilities, medical care, prescriptions, and other critical expenses, helping neighbors get through a difficult moment and stay on their feet.
- **Share New Beginnings Furniture Program** – A home should feel like home. Share collects quality, gently used furniture and delivers it to local families who are starting over, including many transitioning from homelessness. A bed, sofa, table, and few extra touches can help turn an empty space into a home.
- **Seasonal Support** – Share helps local children and families experience the excitement and dignity of special occasions. In the summer, we provide new school supplies to children in need. During the holiday season, we provide gifts to registered clients, helping families celebrate even when times are tough.
