- Founded in 1969, Share began with a vision to make a positive difference in the lives of neighbors in need across McLean, Great Falls, and the Pimmit area of Falls Church (zip codes 22101, 22102, 22066, and part of 22043).
- Share of McLean is an all-volunteer, community-based nonprofit that partners with individual donors and local organizations to support neighbors facing food insecurity, economic hardship, and other challenges.
- With no paid staff, no office space, and no fundraising expenses, nearly every donation goes directly to the clients we serve.

Our Core Values

- We value our clients and treat them with kindness, respect, and generosity.
- We value our donors and are deeply grateful for their charitableness and partnership.
- We think of our volunteers as family and are inspired by their commitment and dedication.

Who are our clients?

Share supports 1,400 households—over 3,500 individuals—who are facing financial hardship, living on fixed incomes, or experiencing housing instability. Clients are referred to us by local faith communities, county social workers, school counselors, and other nonprofit organizations.

What are our Major Programs?

- Food and Clothing Pantry From donated space at McLean Baptist Church, Share provides essential groceries and gently used clothing to families in need. Each month, we distribute more than 900 bags of food and 300 bags of clothing.
- Emergency Financial Aid In partnership with Fairfax County, Share offers urgent financial assistance to help neighbors cover rent, utilities, medical care, prescriptions, and other critical expenses.
- **Furniture Program** We collect donated furniture from the community and deliver clean, gently used pieces to families and individuals—many of them transitioning from homelessness.
- **Seasonal Support** Each summer, Share provides new back-to-school supplies for children in need, and in the fall, we distribute holiday gifts to our registered clients.

Our Current Needs

Share operates entirely through the generosity of our community—receiving no government funding. We rely on donations of food, clothing, and funds, as well as the time and talents of adult and teen volunteers who want to make a difference through our programs.
